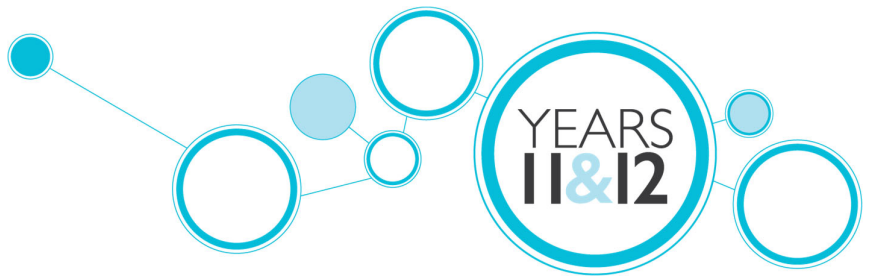

MUSIC LEVEL 3



Amendment Description

Access

Currently the Access description refers to non-school based providers. The proposed change relates students' level of music skills to Australian Curriculum and TASC courses:

- 'This Level 3 course is designed for students who have successfully completed *Music Studies* Level 2 or achieved highly in Band 9-10 Australian Curriculum Music or who hold equivalent skills.

Pathways

Similarly, the current Pathways section does not refer to current pathways in to the course so the following statement has now been added:

'This course provides a pathway for those who have previously studied *Music Studies* Level 2.'

Course Content

Clarity is provided in regards to option selection.

The proposed statement reads:

'Learners will prepare a selection of music.

- For Composition this will be presented through a folio of work with accompanying Audio CD
- For Improvisation this will be presented through live performance'

Criteria and Standards:

Terminology has been updated to add greater clarity:

- The term *music statements* will be replaced by *music* when it refers to the playing of music. This is to differentiate between the practical playing of music and the theoretical components of the course.
- The term *repertoire* has been replaced by *program of works*
- Detail has been added to Criterion 10 to make it clearer which elements are applied when assessing Composition or Improvisation.
